"Personal Security Starts with Me and You". Each of us plays a very important role in making our communities a safe place for everyone.

Contact your community manager if you want to volunteer for a Watch Committee.

- **Do** be aware of people standing near garage or entry doors as you enter or leave.
- **Don't** let strangers or non-residents inside the building.

• **Do** use all areas of the apartment community with the appropriate intent and in a responsible manner.



- Don't leave any entrance doors to the community open or wedged open for any reason.
- **Do** notify the community manager if your key or fob is lost or stolen.
- **Don't** give your building fob/key or apartment door keys to anyone or make copies of your keys.
- **Do** call the office about any non-working lights or other safety concerns around the property.
- **Don't** leave blinds and shades open after dark. You don't want your belongings to be seen.
- **Do** consider investing in a low-cost renter's insurance policy. It can save you from having to replace personal belongings in the event of fire, theft, damage, or vandalism.
- **Don't** leave items of value in your vehicle and always lock your car doors, even if you are in the parking garage.
- **Do** be aware of your surroundings when using common areas such as the laundry room, stairwell, or parking lot.
- **Don't** leave windows or doors unlocked, even if you are only going next door, to take out trash, or to do laundry.
- **Do** be respectful of your neighbors' rights to peaceful enjoyment of their home and community.
- **Don't** hesitate to report any suspicious person or behavior to the office and if after office hours, call 911.

Scrumptious Fruit Triangles, a great way to beat the heat!

Summertime is made for fresh fruit. Give this delicious power-packed fruit salsa and cinnamon sugar chips a try!

Salsa:

- ▲ 3 cups cut fresh fruit (kiwi, strawberry, blueberry, mango, pineapple, oranges, any combo of fruit you like)
- ▲ ½ cup fruit juice of choice
- ▲ 1 tsp cornstarch
- ▲ Juice from 1 lime
- 2 Tble mint leaves chopped

Chips:

- ▲ Tortillas
- Cinnamon and sugar mixed
- Oil for heating

Mix cut fruit in large bowl. In a pan, heat fruit juice to a slow boil, add cornstarch and cook until thickened. Cool and fold into fruit mixture. Squeeze lime juice to taste and sprinkle with fresh mint leaves.

In additional pan, pour just enough oil to coat the bottom and heat to 350 degrees. Place tortilla in oil for a few seconds on each side until crispy and browned. Remove from oil and place on paper towel. Sprinkle with cinnamon and sugar while warm and cut into triangles. Dip chips in fruit salsa and enjoy!
